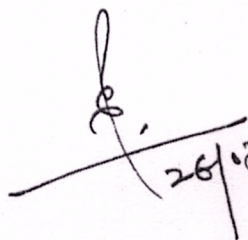
**Subject: Digital Jammu & Kashmir Week, 2022 w.e.f. 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2022, directions thereof.**

With reference to the Digital Jammu & Kashmir Week, 2022 inaugurated by Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor, Jammu & Kashmir on 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2022 at SKICC, Srinagar, the directions of Chief Secretary, J&K regarding activities to be undertaken and completed by Departments/ Deputy Commissioners **by or before 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2022** positively are as under:
